LOCATION: The 200 yard line of Post 435 Gun Club.

TIME: Squadding and set up will begin at 10:00am, shooting will begin aprox. 11:00am

SQUADDING: At the range, Look for the shivering people. Beware of Sasquatch.

FEES: Free for Post 435 Gun Club or CMP Club members, a \$5.00 donation requested from non-members.

RIFLES: Any 22 caliber or smaller Smallbore rifle.

CLASSES: Iron site, optical site, F-class (prone shooting off sandbags) and Benchrest. Perhaps other classes if we get enough interest. COME OUT AND SHOOT!

TARGETS: Official NRA 200 yard targets. SR, SR-42 or MR 52

COURSE OF FIRE:

Match 1: Unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

- If time & weather permit
- Match 2: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.
- Match 3: An aggregate of matches 1 & 2.

RULES: NRA Highpower rules govern, Match Director HAS FINAL SAY .

DUTIES: Competitors will be required to perform Pit Duty and Score for other shooters.

MISC.: A 22LR rifle needs approximately 24 moa of elevation adjustment from a 25yd zero.

COMPETITORS: Open to anyone who want's to shoot a 22 caliber Rifle at 200 yards and have A fun, safe time.
