Preventing and Countering the Use of New and Emerging Technologies for Terrorist Purposes: Way Forward for a Holistic Multilateral Response

The exploitation of new & emerging technologies —particularly ICT, such as the Internet, including social media platforms and online financial tools by terrorists and terrorist groups for organizing a wide range of terrorist activities, has been an issue of serious concerns for Member states. The CTC organized a Special Meeting on the issue in Mumbai and New Delhi on 28-29 October 2022, and adopted Delhi Declaration. The side event will provide a platform to all relevant stakeholders to discuss the issue including the way forward from Delhi Declaration for a holistic multilateral response to this threat.
