Excellency,

It is our distinct pleasure to refer to the decision of the President of the General Assembly of 10 October 2023, appointing us as Co-facilitators of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Revitalization of the Work of the General Assembly (AHWG) during the seventy-eighth session.

At the outset, we wish to reiterate our firm commitment to the advancement of the intergovernmental negotiations on the Revitalization of the General Assembly, with a focus on facilitating meaningful engagement, through participative and inclusive dialogues among Member States and other stakeholders.

Our aim for the upcoming months is to accelerate progress on the implementation of mandates stemming from previous resolutions on the topic of the General Assembly Revitalization, while at the same time promoting an innovative spirit in addressing the challenges that remain unabated thus far.

Pursuant to Resolution 77/335 of 1 September 2023, during the seventy-seventh session, the AHWG will hold consultations with Member States on the first two thematic clusters: *the Role and Authority of the General Assembly* and *the Working Methods of the General Assembly*. To that end, we are pleased to share with you a roadmap outlining the schedule of consultations, that will serve as the basis for the planned interactions in the months ahead:

- **20 February 2024 – General Debate on the Revitalization of the Work of the General Assembly;**
- **28 March 2024 – First Thematic Debate on the Role and Authority of the General Assembly**
- **22 April 2024 – Second Thematic Debate on the Working Methods of the General Assembly**
- **28 June 2024 – Interactive Dialogue between the Permanent Missions and the United Nations Secretariat**

As co-facilitators of the AHWG, we endeavour to provide any assistance required during the upcoming months and we hope to count on your delegation's engagement and support throughout the consultation process.
