Sunday, June 30th Individual ★ NRA Registered ID 2024182644 ★ All matches are slow fire, 2 sighters + 20 shots for record in 22 minutes. Match 5: 600 yds. (22 minutes with unlimited sighters for fouling) Match 6: 600 yds Match 7: 600 yds Match 8: 600 yds Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 (140 points possible) *All matches must be shot with the same rifle.

Classification: The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. If there are less than 5 competitors in any classification, they will be combined with the next higher class, until the 5-competitor minimum is satisfied. High Masters will not be combined with any other classification. If there are less than 5 High Masters competing, they will be eligible for Match Winner only. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Challenges: \$2.00 per challenge. Competitors should have exact change.
Range Capacity: 69 Shooters on 3 relays, 92 Shooters on 4 relays if needed.

Eligibility: All competitors are encouraged to be NRA members. Elk River Sportsman's Club reserves the right to reject any entry, though we can't imagine why we would. All "unclassified" shooters must present their equipment for inspection. All competitors must have a confirmed 600 yard zero. Out State competitors will be allowed to be Tournament champion only if a member of the MRRA.

Targets:Shotmarker Electronic targets F-Class600 yards – MR-1FShotmarker Electronic targets Sling600 yards – MR-1

Sling/ Service rifle Shooters: State champ and match winners must shoot 4 out of the 7 matches with iron sights to be State Champ or Match winner.

Award Schedule: There will be cash awards (subject to 5-competitor per class minimum). F-Open, F-TR, Sling & Service Rifle will have separate awards. Medals or trophies awarded in each class/discipline.

Registration: Paid pre-registration is strongly encouraged. An e-mail with your name, address, NRA #, discipline and classification, with a check sent via US Mail, will suffice. Entries will be accepted at the statistical office between 7:00 AM to 8:15 AM. *No entries will be accepted after* 8:20 AM. Firing point & relay assignments will be made at that time. Mandatory safety meeting before match begins. All match participants must have a confirmed 600 yard zero for their rifle before registering. If not, the 100 yard range will be manned for zero verification from 8:00am until 8:30am on Saturday only. Fouling shots will be allowed prior to Match #1 and #5. Please see **Eligibility** section above. Be on time!!!
